Nipissing First Nation - Crisis Control Group (CCG) continues to closely monitor the COVID-19 situation and adapt our pandemic response as needed. With the current status of cases and modelling projecting increasing daily case counts heading into the holidays, NFN management wants to be proactive in planning for the New Year. Today, Nipissing First Nation announced that they are taking proactive measures in closing the offices to the public in January and encouraging staff who can work from home to do so starting December 20, 2021 until January 21, 2022.

Effective December 20, 2021, Nbisiing Secondary School staff and students will move to a virtual platform. Virtual learning will begin on **December 20 and 21, 2021** and will resume on the virtual platform on **January 5, 2022**. The school intends to return to in-person learning on Monday, January 24, 2022.

For families that have signed up to receive a food hamper, they will be delivered Monday, December 20th and Tuesday, December 21st, 2021. All in-person students will also be provided with rapid antigen screening kits, with safety recommendations and instructions for voluntary use, as well as all school supplies and assignments required for the two weeks we plan to be virtual. Teachers have prepared packages for students as necessary that will be delivered with the hampers.
